1. Love Like Jesus

We live with unconditional purposeful love! Jesus loves people just the way they are, and He loves them enough not to leave them that way. Jesus teaches us to love everyone, even our enemies.

2. Live Like Jesus

We live God's Word! Jesus lived by the Word of God. Our attitudes and actions need to be guided by the Scriptures.

3. Give Like Jesus

We practice radical generosity! God so loved that He gave. Jesus expresses the generosity of God. We desire to be blessed so that we can be a blessing.

4. Serve Like Jesus

We serve to bring joy! Serving people are happy people. "Serve the Lord with gladness" (Psalm 100:2). "These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full." (John 15:11) We believe that we don't come to church to "sit" but to "serve."

5. Pray Like Jesus

We see mountains move! Jesus' disciples asked Him to teach them how to pray. Jesus says that His house should be called a "house of prayer for all people." We believe that prayer changes things; and, prayer changes us!

WHAT IS KINGDOM BUILDERS?

Jesus teaches us to, “Seek first the kingdom... and **ALL** these things will be given to you. (Matthew 6).” When we support the things God loves, then God supports our lives in incredible ways.

Kingdom Builders are people who support our spiritual community in:

Prayer

Kingdom Builders regularly join in prayer for all that God desires to do in and through us.

Partnership

Kingdom Builders are a part of what God is doing here at Hope. They give of their time, talents, and treasure. Kingdom Builders freely share their time to come to church and serve in ministries that share God’s love. They also give their talents to honor God and help God’s people.

Kingdom Builders are also tithing partners with HOPE. They honor God with the first portion of their income. The portion God teaches us to give is 10%, also called the tithe. We learn to tithe from Abraham (Genesis 14), Moses (Leviticus 27), and Jesus tells us we should tithe (Matthew 23). When we give God the first, God blesses the rest.

Provision

Kingdom Builders make a commitment to give Faith Promise offerings beyond their tithe. They supply provision for the vision we share. Faith promises are simply praying and asking the Lord what he will provide us to give by faith. This stretches our love and generosity. As we are generous, God pours back into our lives. (Luke 6) These faith promises support missions, missionaries, and ministry expansion, both here and around the world.

Plan for Generosity

This means taking the time to make a plan for how we can make giving happen in our lives. (What will my giving beyond my tithe be this year?)

Vision for Generosity

This means thinking big, beyond our own abilities, and believing God for generosity beyond what we have seen. (What is my dream amount that I hope to give one day that is beyond my wildest dreams?)

City Serve

We were able to distribute \$126 million in goods and serve a total of 2.5 million people in 2023. We have had an all-time impact of 1.2 billion goods distributed to help those in need. All praise to God!

Community Compassion Centers

In 2023, we officially opened our Community Compassion Center Sarasota and now are giving out everything from furniture to clothes and even food between our Sarasota location and our Palmetto location. We have been able to bless our church community, other church communities, the needy in our community, and those who have fallen on hard times. We are so excited about what we can do with these compassion centers!

Sarasota Medical Pregnancy Center

In 2023, we served over 1400 new clients! We conducted over 800 ultrasounds performed and helped 250 male clients as well. We served 3800 people overall and gave away 15,000 diapers. We had nearly 10,000 visits. We are looking forward to continue to help families and lead them to Christ!

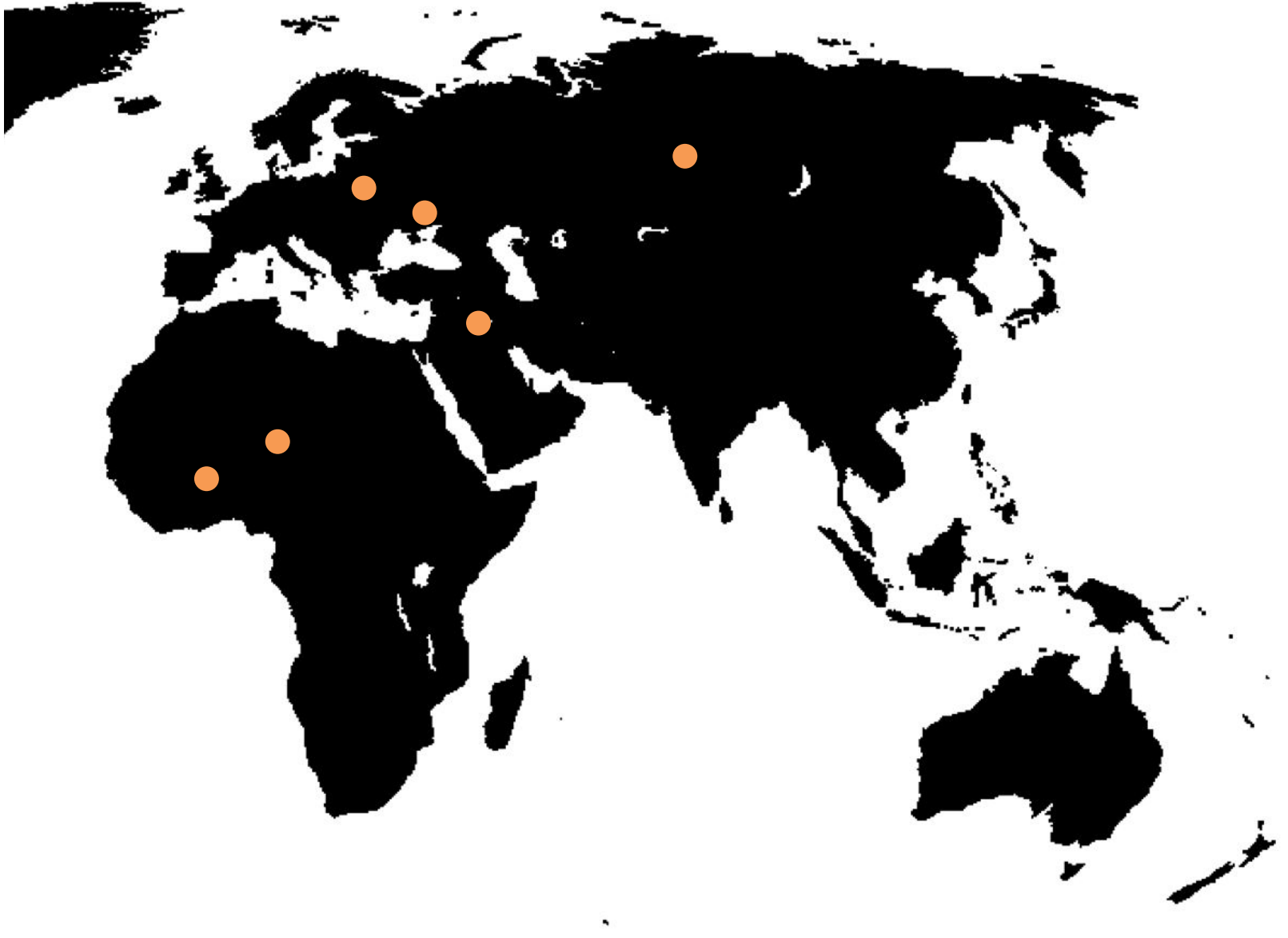

God has been so gracious in setting up places to live / contacts / providing all we need. We have started an educational center and we are building relationships in the community. Please pray for us that we can reach these Muslims for Christ!

Last year in Canary Islands, we saw 3 youth come to know Christ through our relationships in the community. Not only that, we saw 9 people get baptized in all of last year, which is a big number for us. We have really seen our community become closer within the church by God's grace and we are so thankful!

Biggest Win: We travel to many area villages preaching the Gospel, we have kids camps throughout the year, we have a community school, and we often give and we constantly see people who are transformed by God's power. We have been able to see many widows and students who we were able to sponsor to go to university from our community school. We have been able to help some villages receive wells. Thank you for all your prayer and support!

In the last four years in Czeck Republic, we have led 160 people to Jesus.

In the last four years, we have had upwards of 500 salvations as a direct result of the churches we built." "Because of those churches we built, there became multiple places where people found hope beyond just churches, and those numbers could easily reach into the tens of thousands of those impacted for the kingdom of God.

Because the area where we work is extremely sensitive and resistant, we don't have numbers to offer of those being saved or baptized. Instead, we have ongoing people who are on a JOURNEY to accepting truth and knowing Jesus as their own Savior. Every week friends gather in our home to hear stories from God's Word, and they are learning about His character, His power, and His love for them. Each team member also has their own relationships with friends, where intentional conversations are happening and Jesus is being shared through friendship.

Our soccer academy also provides an open door for relationships with players and their parents. The prayers, the work, the gatherings, the coaching, is all done with one goal, SOULS. We thank you so much for your prayers.



Nelson & Rennae Defreitas

Our ministry at SAGU has seen people come to Christ through our student missions association. We have eleven community outreach groups and sent 11 missions teams last year. I can share that we have seen 63 SAGU alumni serve as AG US or AGWM missionaries during our time at the school. A number of them have continued as career missionaries. This is a huge win for the kingdom of God!



Wayne and Tammy Brown

Of the nearly 85,000 towns and villages in Thailand, slightly more than 5,000 do not have any Christians present within the community. The Northeastern Thailand district (where we live) has more than 40 villages, but only one has a few Thai Christians. Our district had no Christians when we moved here 18 months ago. Now, there are four. Praise the Lord!

Recently, we saw a young man named Yang, who was possessed by a demon, be completely set free and transformed by the power of Jesus and even began to speak in spiritual language by the power of the Holy Spirit! Please keep him and those we minister to in your prayers.

In 2023 we saw 250 salvations in the schools we work in Columbia. In the jails, we got to minister to almost 900 inmates and saw almost 400 salvations in those prisons. We have even had an open door to get into juvenile detention centers and minister to those. Because you give and pray, we can go!



Doug and Susan Sayers

In 2023, we saw some amazing things happen. When 30 day Visa's were the most you could hope for in Bolivia, we prayed and entered the country and miraculously received a 10 year Visa. We also received an invitation from the Santa Cruze District's Executive Directors to begin working with local pastors and their students to plant bible clubs in secular high schools. This kind of ministry has never been done! With that, we have been able to assemble a team to translate discipleship materials into Spanish. These materials will be used to train high school students to be Gospel fluent and to lead in their bible clubs.

God is moving in southern Russia among unreached peoples. Continue to pray with us for our friends who are equipping local believers to be disciple-makers among their Muslim neighbors.

Among a local group of gypsy believers, they have already seen 16 people become active in reaching and discipling their now-saved neighbors. We rejoice for new life among the gypsies of southern Russia.

We have been serving in Romania for 6 years and just started with a handful of people and today we have 70! (Which for our context is incredible) In 2023, we had two baptisms, praise God! We have hosted over 1500 people on their campus to make connections with which we are praying leads to salvation and revival. You're generosity has helped make this happen!

When we moved to Africa, our goal was to multiply ourselves--to see the greatest season of fruitfulness so far. Thanks to the Lord's help, and your partnership, in the past 18 months we have helped to train over 300 Bible school teachers, who, in turn, teach over 22,500 students! Thank you, Church of Hope, for making this possible. By extension, you played a part in training over 22,500 men and women to plant and pastor churches throughout East Africa!

This last year, we saw Jesus do so many incredible things in our ministry in the Philipines. We have been able to personally raise up 22 evangelists in our home who are being released to do missions. We saw hundreds come to Christ and be filled with the Holy Spirit in crusades we were able to lead. The church we lead has been growing in numbers and we are getting ready to plant a second church in an area that has had a demonic stronghold for decades. Our church is right next to a military base in Japan and so with that, we get to minister to 3 groups of people. We minister to military members, international community, and native Japanese people. A big win is taking place in Southern Philippines, it is a culmination of 12 years of prayer and planning. Today there are more than 40 Filipino church planters living and working where no Christian has ever lived on our Southern Islands. Due to the dominant faith's opposition to our message, no one has ever gone there to share the Gospel. From these Never-Reached locations, we are now hearing testimonies of conversions and baptisms. God is Good.

This last year in Spain has been incredible as our church as seen hundreds become followers of Christ and many of those, a good majority being Catalans, got baptized as well! We have seen monthly salvations and baptisms, praise be to God! If that isn't amazing enough, we were given a building in downtown Barcelona! We expect to be fully in the building by Easter 2025 and are so excited for this incredible place and location to reach many more for the kingdom of God!

In Thailand this last year, we have had many teams come over and help us share the message of the gospel with the Thai people! 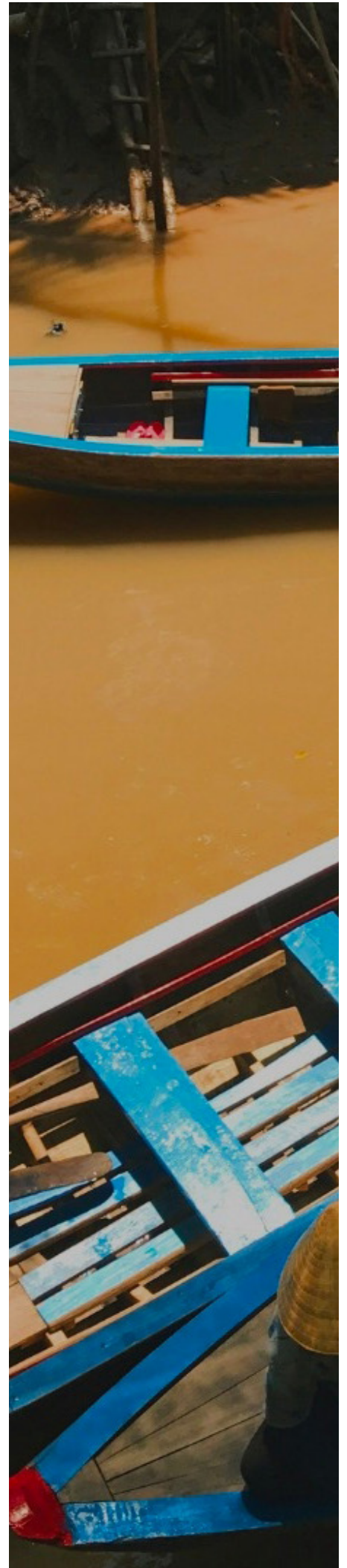
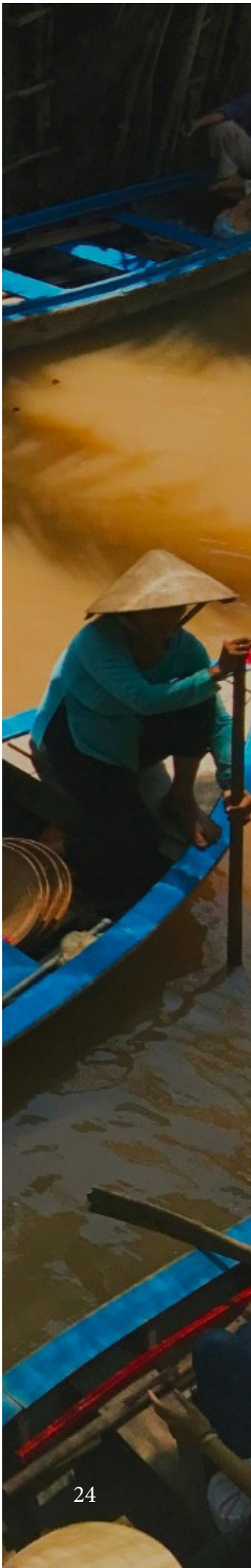
The continent of Europe is in desperate need of ministers to be trained up and

Sarasota Campus

We started in 2023 with meetings at homes with 3 families and a few young people and today we have a building where we can officially meet and grow where we have weekly services now! 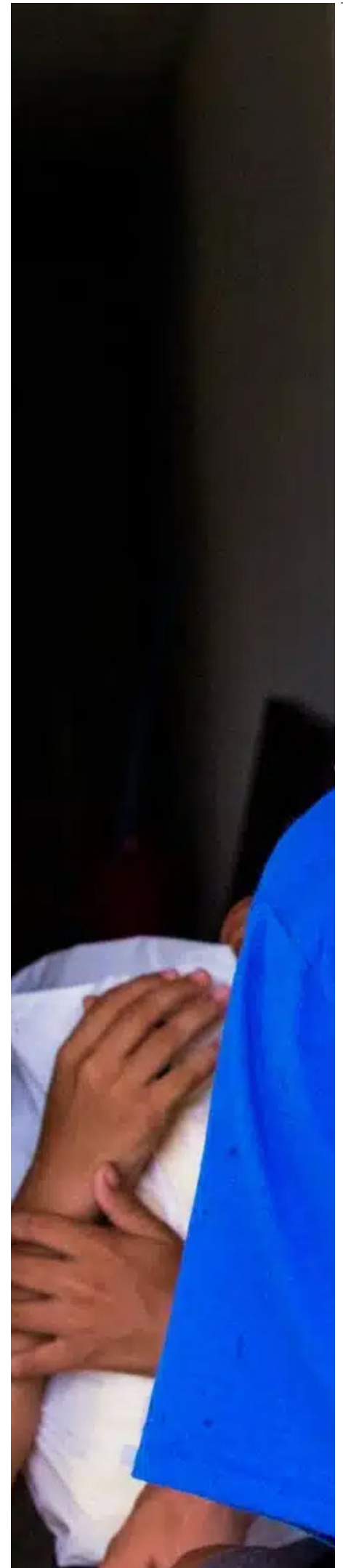






Convoy of Hope

In 2023, our biggest win was helping those in the Ukraine and the Middle East. We were able to send so much aid to help these places because of the people who had a heart to give. God is doing great things through this work!







Light For the Lost (LFTL)

In 2023, every second, of every minute, of every day, someone is using a LFTL-funded resource somewhere on earth. LFTL continues to provide funds that allow missionaries to have evangelism resources in print, audio, video, internet tech, and apps. One of the most exciting digital techs we help fund is the Pattern App platform. This allows missionaries to create evangelistic apps in local languages and distribute them for FREE to secret house churches, believers in isolated locations, and also above-ground churches. In places where a printing press or physical Bibles is simply

impossible, the Pattern Apps allow believers to have a printing press AND a Bible in their pocket at all times. Between two missionary projects in El Salvador and Colombia, we helped reach more than 30,000 people with personal contacts and gospel portions in print and on audio devices. We have begun the process to help lead hundreds of churches in Africa through the Acts 2 Journey which will certainly increase their evangelistic activity and effectiveness. Eventually as many as 1,000 churches per year could go through A2J with help from LFTL. A new ministry to women and girls in Europe called The INSPIRE Project has launched. LFTL funds provide all the materials used to teach the Bible and lead women



and girls to a decision for Christ. Numerous salvations are reported in each INSPIRE meeting. So far they have had outreaches in Austria, Iceland, and Romania. Teen Challenge is doing awesome with help from LFTL! In the U.S. virtually every TC center uses LFTL funds to provide the materials and teaching helps that TC students use to learn the Bible and move through discipleship processes. This is also true in scores of Global Teen Challenge locations. This last year, about 30 young girls and boys in Philippines who were sexually exploited online by trafficking rings were rescued by police and brought to a secret home/school run by AG missionaries. Each of these kids are being helped and restored with

LFTL funding, which provides Bibles, Christian videos, and teaching materials to help the children reintegrate into society as adults. Another human trafficking ministry, Project Rescue, continues using LFTL funds to initiate secret rescue operations in Spain, France, and Finland. The LFTL funds provide items that have messages on them encouraging trafficked women to realize the God has not abandoned them and wants to set them free spiritually and physically. But a little under 20 women were rescued through these means in the past year. Praise God for what he is doing through Light for the Lost!



Cry of India

8.1 million children between 6-13 years do not have access to education in India. Home to a quarter of all undernourished people worldwide, one in every three malnourished children in the world lives in India. About 50% of all childhood deaths are attributed to malnutrition. Contaminated water causes 1,600 deaths daily. 6 days a week, we provide a nourishing meal to 10,000 children and adults of needy families. Our child care service facilitates sponsorship for over 5,000 needy children in 57 schools across East India. We are committed to combating disease in India by providing clean water to families and children. Through our clean water initiative, 3000 Bio Sand filters have been installed and are being used in 34 villages over Jharkhand and West Bengal. In 2023, we provided over 3 million meals for needy people!





Priority One

Priority One is dedicated to Christian leadership development through the building of Bible training centers around the world. We fund brick and mortar solutions in order to develop church leaders wherever there is a need. With your help we have helped build classrooms, dormitories, and libraries in over 50 countries! We have also delivered e-readers loaded with curriculum, financed water wells, and provided motorcycles and bicycles to pastors serving remote areas. Praise God for providing what we need to fulfill his mission!



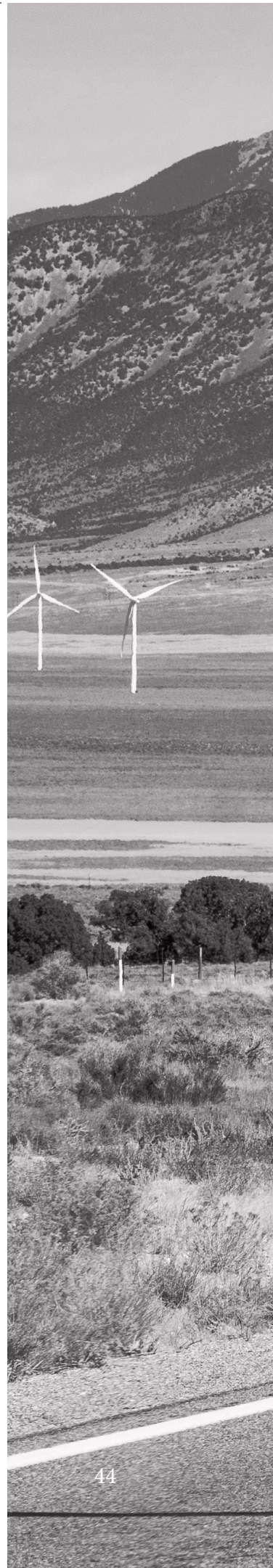




Hispanic Campus

Our Hispanic Campus has grown to about 40 people in 2023. They have seen numerous lives changed this last year. From people who have stepped up to serve and lead in the ministry, as well as a few salvations! One of their biggest wins this last year was helping plant Hope Argentina and equipping them with everything they need to thrive as a church. Keep praying for our Spanish ministries and praise God for how they are flourishing!





Las Vegas Campus

In 2023, we launched a Las Vegas Campus and we have seen 10 salvations and about 30 attending regularly. Praise God for his blessings on his Las Vegas campus!







Portuguese Campus

Our Igreja “Portuguese Campus” had 20 baptisms and 40 Salvations in 2023. We averaged a weekly attendance of 200 last year. About 70 attended connect groups weekly.







Palmetto Campus

Our Palmetto Campus has seen God do amazing things in 2023. We saw 23 decisions for Jesus and got to baptize 9 people. We fed an average of 670 people each week through compassion ministries. We were able to renovate our campus and make it look amazing! Praise the Lord! We were able to see over 100 new guests walk through our doors. God is moving and we are looking ahead to what He is going to continue to do.





Brazil Campus

Our Brazil campus has seen God move mightily in 2023. We had 11 decisions for Christ, 6 baptisms, 3 Hope groups started, and a weekly gathering of over 25 people! We even had 12 people go through our discipleship process! Praise God!





Speed The Light (STL)

In 2023 we raised \$2598.87 so others can speed the light of the gospel to a world in darkness. Speed the Light (STL) engages, teaches, and discipless our youth in God's mission to reach the lost! This is accomplished by creating a heart of missional generosity in students for the world's needs and our missionaries' needs. Students are challenged to sacrificially give to missions, reach the lost in their own area, and pray for missionaries around the globe.





Boys & Girls Missionary Challenge (BGMC)

In 2023, we raised \$10,536.54 for Boys & Girls Missionary Challenge. BGMC (Boys and Girls Missionary Challenge) is a missions-focused program within the Assemblies of God designed to teach children about the importance of supporting global missions. Through BGMC, kids learn about different cultures and the needs of missionaries around the world. The program encourages children to raise funds to help provide missionaries with the supplies and resources they need to share the gospel, including educational materials, equipment, and humanitarian aid. BGMC combines education, compassion, and fundraising efforts, fostering a heart for giving and service in young participants.
